Carlisle Spray Foam Insulation (CSFI) is pleased to introduce SealTite One, an HFO spray foam insulation designed specifically for use in Canada.

Blowing agent changes are required January 1, 2021, for every Canadian Province and Territory, with very few exceptions. The Montreal Protocol, in its 9th amendment, has committed Canada to the phase down, and ultimate ban, of HFC blowing agents in an effort to curb the effects of climate change.

Carlisle is leading the Canadian market in comparison to other spray foam insulation manufacturers, having tested to the 2015 standard for CAN/ULC-S705.1, which goes above requirements for earlier versions, including the 2001 edition. As building codes change, it is important to be at the forefront of testing and performance. Architects, specification writers, building officials, and owners can rest assured that SealTite One meets and exceeds the Provincial and National Building Codes.
